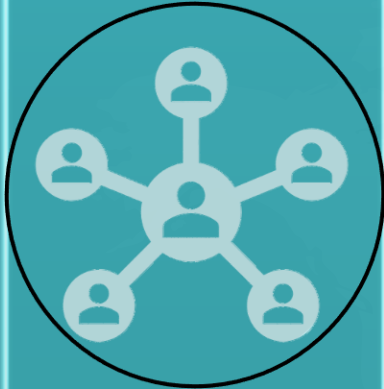

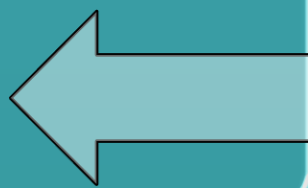

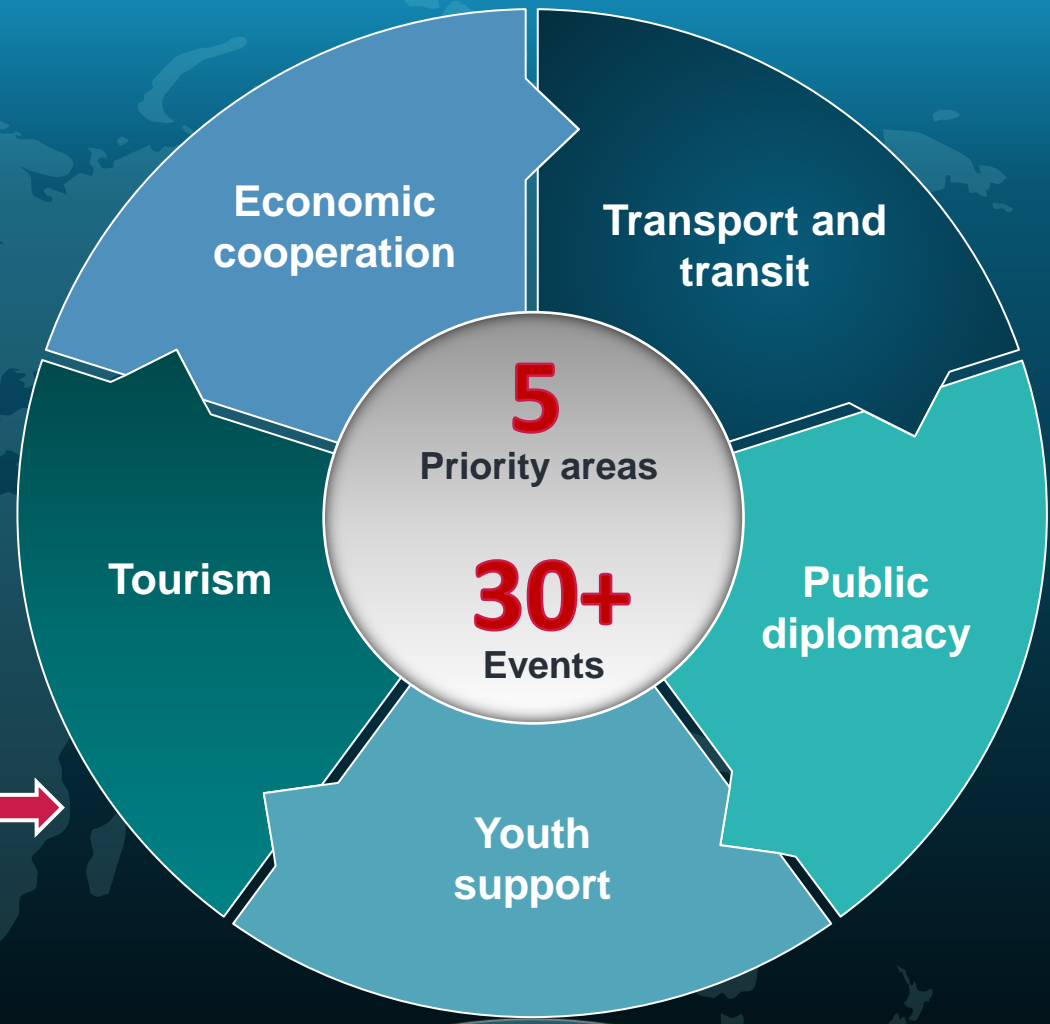
Rules of Procedure of the OTS

Legally binding documents in specific sectors were signed for the first time in the history of the OTS.

Adopted upon the initiative of Uzbekistan



- For the first time in the history of the Organization, Uzbekistan started its chairpersonship with the **Concept of the Chairpersonship** and the **Plan of Activities**.
- More than 30 events in 5 priority areas of the Chairpersonship were included in the Concept.

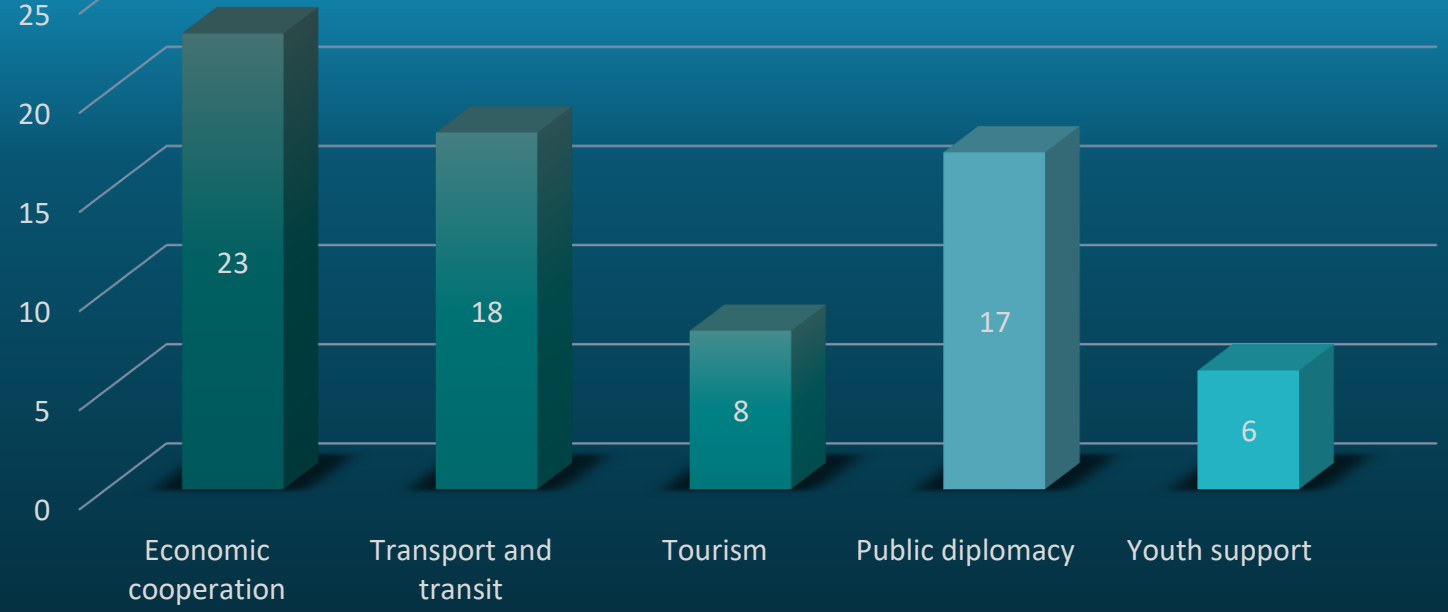


Number of events held under the chairpersonship of Uzbekistan

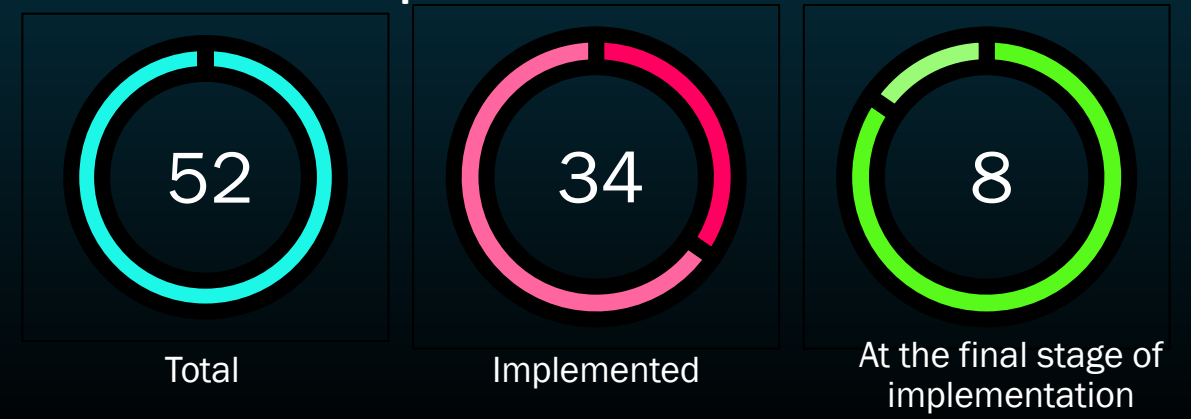

• The OTS Ankara Summit was held under the chairpersonship of the President of Uzbekistan

• Meetings of the Security Councils' Secretaries, Council of Elders, Heads of space agencies and human resources departments were organized in Uzbekistan

• Meetings of Ministers in Charge of Education and Health were held in Uzbekistan

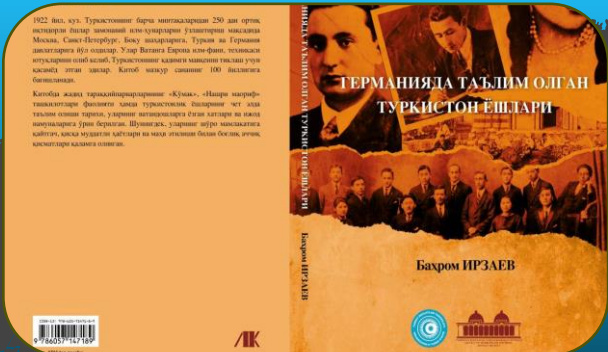


• Agreement establishing Turkic Investment Fund was signed in Ankara



• Special Meeting of Rectors of the Turkic Universities Union (TURKUNIB) was held in Uzbekistan





• The book dedicated to the Youth of Turkistan was published

• "Tabarruk Ziyorat" project aimed to connect Turkistan city with Tashkent, Samarkand, Bukhara and Khiva started



• International Congress of Science and Innovation of Youth of the Turkic World was held in Tashkent



• At the initiative of the President of Uzbekistan, the collection "Masterpieces of Turkic Literature," consisting of 100 volumes, was published in Uzbek language.



• Conferences devoted to Afrosiyob and Jadids were held in Uzbekistan





The first block train on the Izmir-Tashkent route was launched.

Scheduled block train routes are planned to establish among the Parties.



The "ePermit" project was implemented between Uzbekistan and Türkiye, and 5,000 electronic permit forms for 2023 have been exchanged.

Efforts are currently in progress to extend this project to involve other Member States.



The International Forum "Transport Connectivity of Turkic States: Fergana-Anadolu" was conducted in the city of Fergana. Over 120 representatives of transport companies, manufacturers, and exporters from the Member States participated in the forum.



The International Multimodal Transport and Logistics Forum took place in Istanbul.

Over 300 delegates, including executives from major transport companies, manufacturers, exporters, and Heads of railway agencies from member and observer countries, were in attendance.
